

Difficult Airway Management Course for ODPs, Anaesthetic Nurses and Paramedics

This is a one day course for all non-medical practitioners who are involved in airway management of patients.

The aims of the course:

- To develop an understanding of the potential problems with difficult airways.
- To identify skills so that the non-medical practitioner and the anaesthetist can sing from the same hymn sheet when managing a difficult airway
- Teach skills that they can apply in their routine working day.
- Teach how to set up and check the equipment required for fiberoptic intubation.
- Cleaning and sterilisation of the Fibrescope.
- Setting up a difficult intubation trolley.
- An update on various airway devices currently in use in the UK.

Composition of the course

- Concise lectures to include Airway anatomy and assessment, endotracheal intubation, Difficult airway, C-spine and the airway and a Guest lecture.
- An airway scenario on a medium fidelity mannequin (Sim man)
- Interactive sessions.
- An afternoon of practical hands on work stations.
